Background Information:

DK is a 6-year-old male initially evaluated at the Boston Children's Health Physicians Speech and Language Clinic in June 2018. The client was referred for a comprehensive speech and language evaluation due to concerns regarding intelligibility. DK currently lives with his parents, younger sister, and baby brother. The primary language spoken in the home is English. DK presents with an articulation disorder, characterized by a lateral lisp affecting /s/ and /z/ production, as well as gliding (e.g., wed for read, weal for real) affecting /r/ production.

Long Term Goal(s):

1. DK will produce age-appropriate speech sounds.

Short Term Goal(s):

1. DK will produce initial /l/ at the conversation level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.
Status: *Goal met.*
Progress: DK independently produced sentences in conversation containing initial /l/ with 100% accuracy. This goal was achieved on 7/19/22.
2. DK will produce medial /l/ at the sentence level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.
Status: *Goal met.*
Progress: DK independently produced sentences containing medial /l/ with 88% accuracy across 3 sessions. This goal was achieved on 7/19/22.
3. DK will produce final /l/ at the sentence level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.
Status: *Goal met.*

Progress: DK independently produced sentences containing final /l/ with 75% accuracy across 3 sessions; however, goal was not targeted in consecutive sessions. This goal was achieved on 7/19/22.

4. DK will produce initial /s/ at the word level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.

Status: *Goal not met. Ongoing.*

Progress: DK continues to make inconsistent progress toward this goal. DK produced initial /s/ at the word level with 53% accuracy given moderate verbal placement cues. He benefits from verbal cues reminding him to utilize proper lingual placement, as well as highly motivating reinforcements throughout the session to help maintain focus and participation. Interdental /s/ production is observed approximately 50% of the time.

5. DK will produce initial /z/ at the word level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.

Status: *Goal not met. Ongoing.*

Progress: This goal was introduced on 8/2/22. DK produced words containing initial /z/ with 30% accuracy during this session and benefited from verbal cues reminding him to utilize proper lingual placement, as interdental /z/ is observed.

Impressions: DK continues to present with a mild articulation disorder. He continues to make gradual progress with /s/ and /z/ in the initial word position.

Recommendations: It is recommended that DK continue to receive speech therapy once a week in order to target the following goals:

1. DK will produce initial /s/ at the word level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.
2. DK will produce initial /z/ at the word level with 80% accuracy given occasional verbal cues.
